

Facts About Lizards

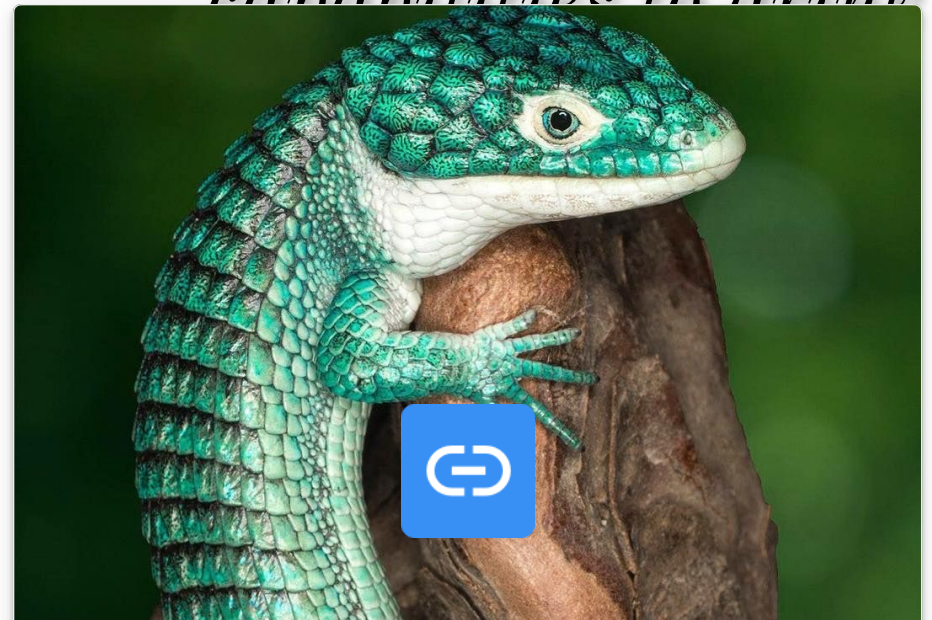
1st fact: Lizards have small heads, They have long bodies and long tails.

During brumation, Lizards bury themselves in holes or dark and hidden places.

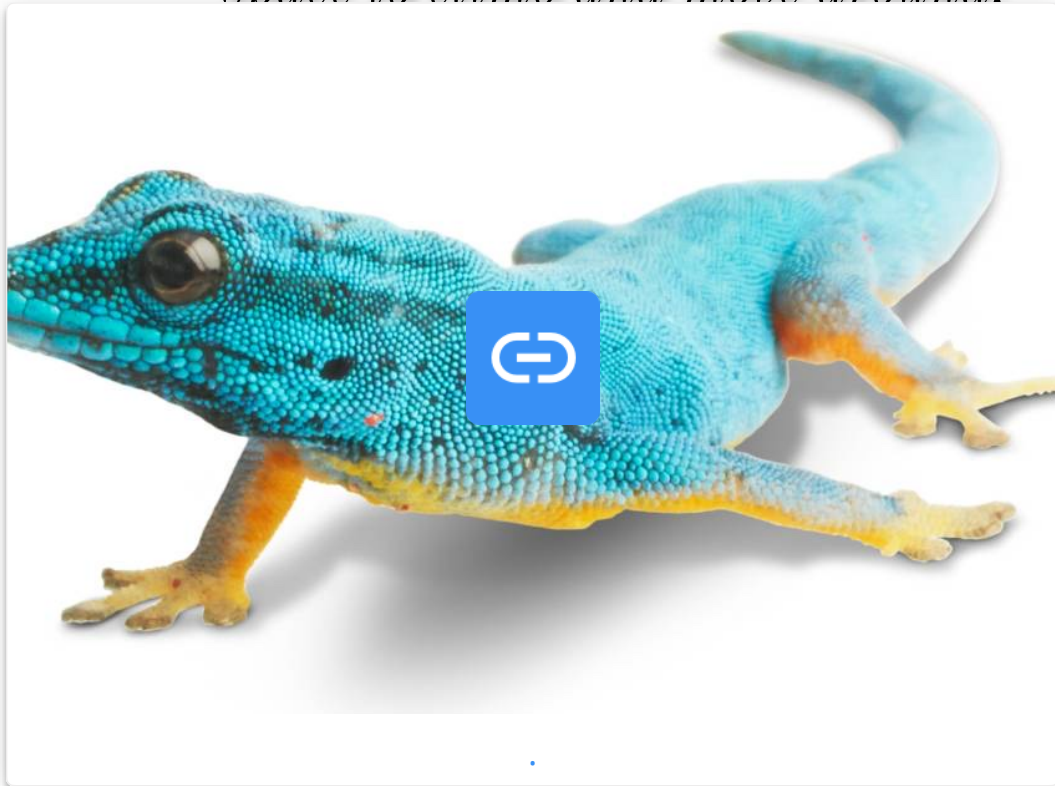
2nd fact: The largest lizard is the Komodo Dragon, It grows up to 10 feet (3 meters) long and weighs up to 176 lbs.
