Otters have strong teeth and a powerful bite so whether you see an otter on land or at sea be sure to maintain a safe distance of at least 50 yards and never feed sea otters

Adult male otters are 22-45kg And Adult female otters are 14-33 kg

Otters can live eight to nine years



Facts about otters

Sea otters have the thickest fur of any animal. Sea otters eat 25 percent of their body weight in food every day.

Baby otters are called pups or kittens.

They stay with their mothers until they're up to a year old

Most sea otters call Alaska home

An otters lung capacity is 2.5 times greater than that of similar sized land mammals. Sea otters have been known to stay under

water for more than 5 minutes at a time.

River otters however can hold their breath for up to 8 minutes.

The increased time underwater improves otters opportunity to sense prey and forage for food.




Food

Otters eat fish shellfish and crabs .while crabs form as much as 80 percent of the otters diet they will also eat other water creatures such as fish and snails as well as small land animals such as lizards frogs and mice



7. Reading your book


Now for the fun bit. Tap on the play button to read your book. You can even have Siri read it you. Try it now with this tutorial!
